Austin Court, Birmingham

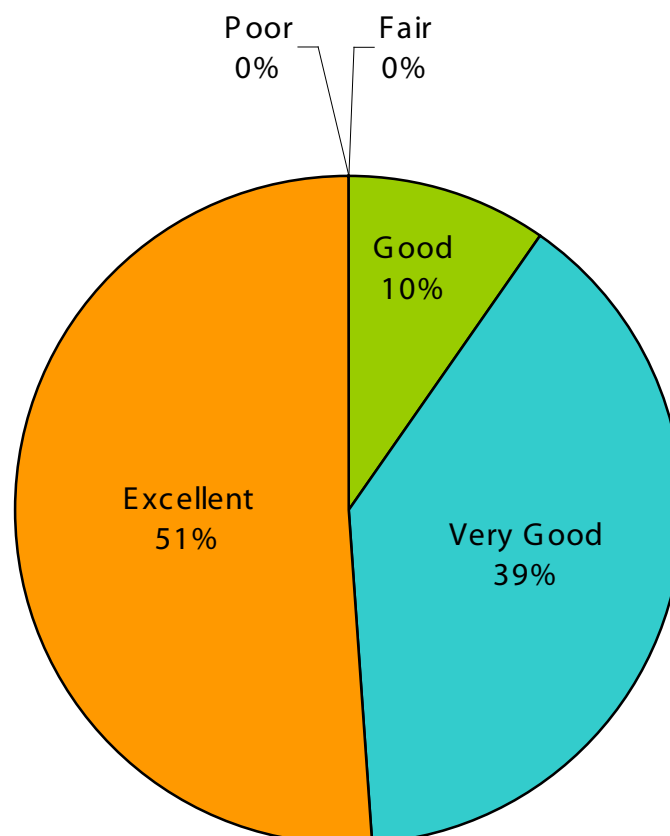

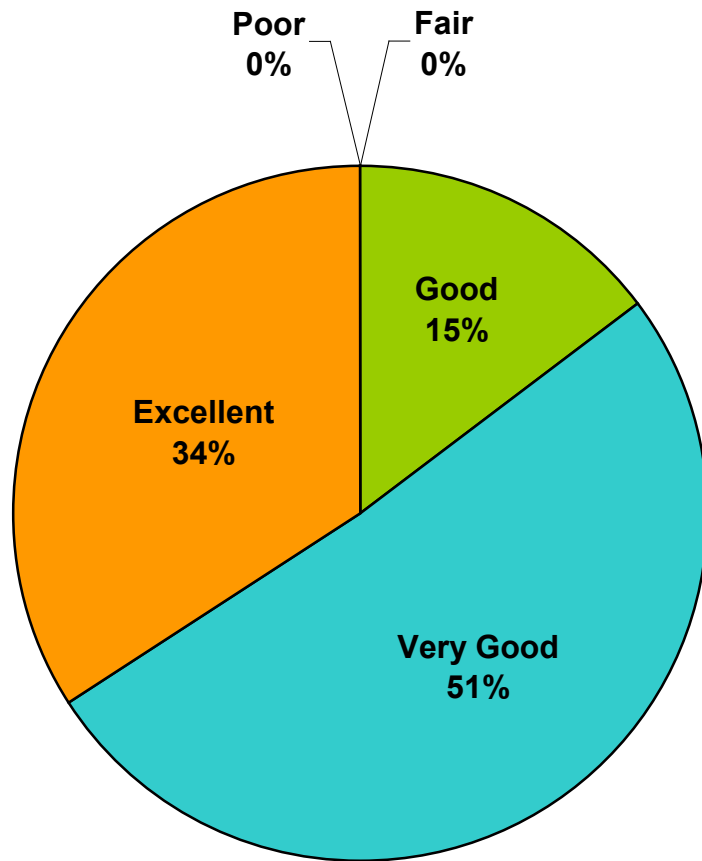
The day was deemed a great success and there are already questions of when the next one will be held.

The following charts are averages of what the delegates had to say about the event.

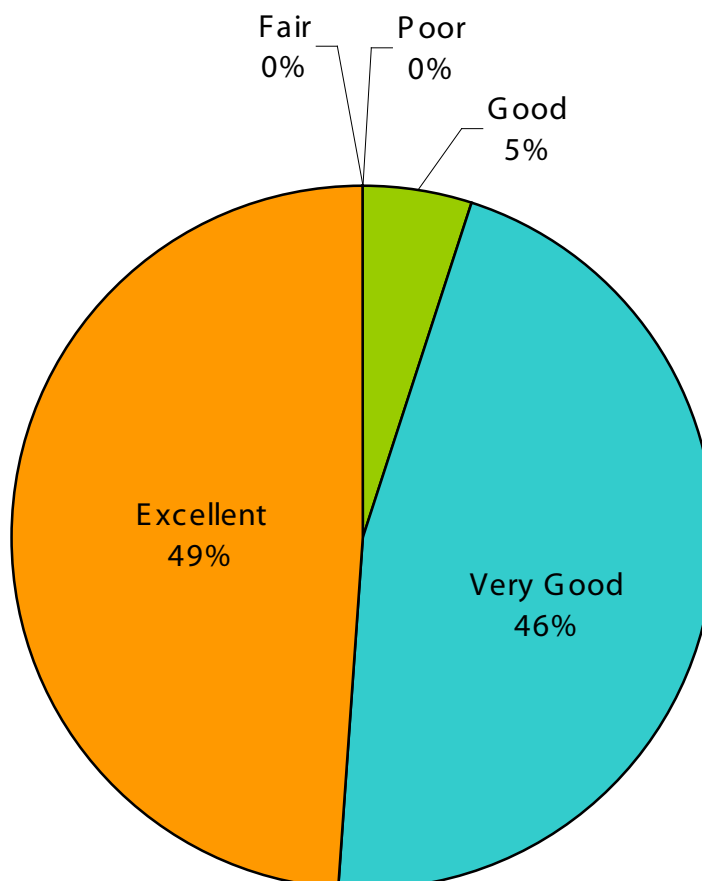
Was the venue convenient and easy to access?



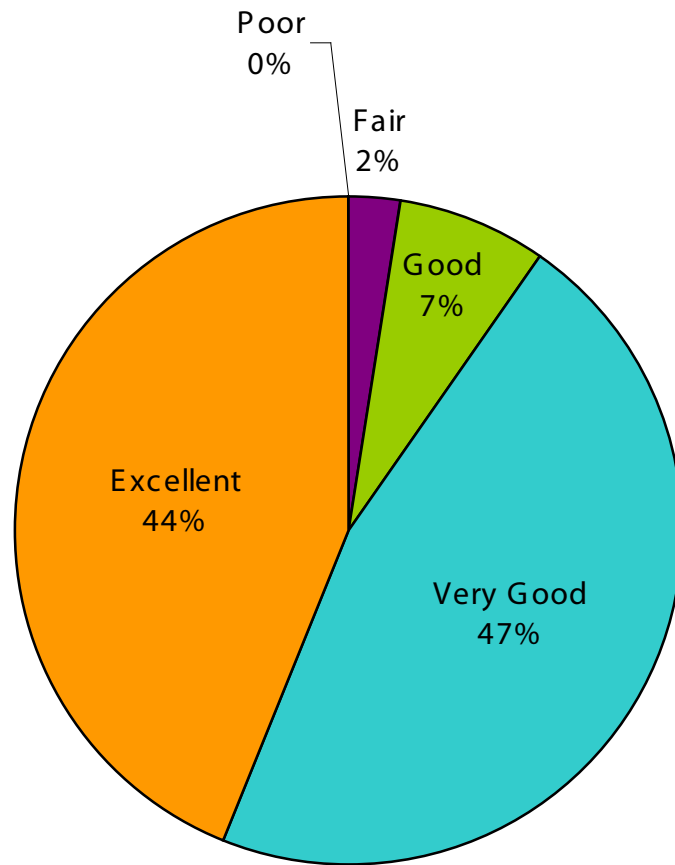
I was given ample opportunity to make a contribution.
