And consider the increasing complexity of needs, the workforce issues, the array of fee structures and its impact on the markets stability and sustainability and the interface with other professionals and stakeholders.

- To have at its heart careful consideration of the experience and outcomes for older people and their families when moving into a care home
- Jointly driven by health and social care in partnership
- Incorporates strong involvement from the sector itself

An analysis of relevant data and evidence relating to the delivery of care in the West Midlands Care Home market

Identification of the issues and areas for development that need to be addressed to enable a responsive, sustainable, high quality care home market for the future and to make associated recommendations as to how this should be achieved.
